## VINTAGE GUN CLASSIFICATION

### **Vintage Pump or a Vintage Semi-auto**

Shooter may use ANY Vintage Pump or a Vintage American Semi-auto in production pre-1952.

**Side-by-Side shotgun –**  
Any Side-by-Side.

**Over/Under –** Any Over Under that was in production pre-1952.

## VINTAGE SKEET RULES

### **Vintage Skeet Rules**

\*Gun Butt must be visible below the elbow when shooter calls for target.

\*Shooter may not begin gun mount until target is visible in the air. Infraction is a “no bird” and target must be repeated.

\*Puller will delay release of targets for up to 3 seconds after shooter calls pull. Delays should be random, between zero and three seconds. Shooter should not be able to anticipate when target will be released. Target SEQUENCING is the same as modern, Speed-up Skeet.
